Scope and Content Note: The Places of Worship Vertical File Collection is an artificial collection of newspaper and magazine clippings that have been individually donated to the Society, collected by staff, or found in collection; they are arranged by denomination. Please note, the collection is not exhaustive and is added to only on a sporadic basis; the Society does not actively collect for this collection. Individual manuscript collections may also contain clippings on many of the same topics, as well as those not included in this artificial collection.

Donor: This collection was created through thousands of individual donations and through staff efforts. Most items are not traceable to a specific accession.
