**Scope and Content:** The Washington, D.C. Architectural Drawing Collection consists of plans for apartment, office, commercial and residential spaces; government agencies; renovations and preliminary plans for construction. Also included in this collection are various landscape plans for projects such as the German American Friendship Garden and the National Grove of State Trees.

This collection is arranged in two series.

**SERIES I: ARCHITECTURAL DRAWINGS** consist of drawings of buildings in and around Washington, D.C. designed by local architects. Drawings were completed for buildings throughout the twentieth century, while some represent nineteenth century structures. Building plans contained in this collection include: Hampshire Garden Apartments, House for Mr. G.H. Grosvenor, John A. Wilson Building, Transmitter Station for WOL and the American Red Cross. Architects include Waddy B. Wood, Captain Montgomery C. Meigs, Harvey Warwick, George Santmeyer, Marsh & Peter, and Angelos Demetriou & Associates. There are prints in the collection that are untitled and many are unidentifiable otherwise. These prints, however can still serve as an interesting study in building design.

**SERIES II: THE CATHEDRAL STONE COMPANY DRAWINGS** were drawn primarily in the 1980s. The Cathedral Stone Company was located at 2505 Reed Street, Washington, DC and owned by Dennis Rude. According promotional brochure, the Company's mission was to provide "planning, consultation, fabrication and on occasion the installation of building stone..." for "...window sills, steps, entrances, cornerstones, architectural carvings, ornaments and decorative motifs." The Cathedral Stone Company specialized in preservation and restoration work. Projects devised by the Cathedral Stone Company include: Lucy Diggs Slowe Hall, St. Elizabeth's Chapel, Pohick Episcopal Church, Prudential Insurance Company, Peter Muhlenberg Memorial, Renwick's Smithsonian Building and several local residences.

While Cathedral Stone Company is no longer in business, Mr. Rude has created Cathedral Stone Products, located in Hanover, Maryland, which specializes in mortar sales.

Prints range in medium; while more recent architectural drawings were created using blue line on paper, older drawings were completed on blueprints, vellum, trace and linen.

This collection is arranged in flat files, oversized prints are rolled. Prints have been separated by medium for archival preservation. Oversized prints are accessible with staff assistance. It should be noted that many oversized prints are extremely brittle and should only be viewed after consideration by a staff member.

**Size:** Drawings encompass nine drawers that measure 38 1/2" X 50 1/4" X 2". Eight sets of drawings are rolled on tubes either 3' or 4' long with a diameter of 3 1/4".

**Restrictions:** Staff consideration required to view oversize prints.
